




This extension provides an overview of all address books available in your Thunderbird installation. There are two types of address books available in Thunderbird:  "Accounts"  "Personal Account". A Personal Account is a collection of contacts. Personal address books are not stored in the Inbox, but in a Thunderbird database file. An Account can be opened in the Accounts sidebar. In Thunderbird versions prior to 2.0.0.0, the primary address book was stored in the Inbox and the contacts in the Inbox were not marked as "Send a file to the Inbox" (see SendMessage Options). This meant that an Account opened in the Accounts sidebar was not automatically marked as a contact to which you can send a file. This is not the case any more. As a workaround, you can mark contacts in the Accounts sidebar as "Send a file to the Inbox". That way you will be able to add files to them, but you will not be able to see them in the sidebar any more. As of version 2.0.0.0, a Personal address book is stored in a special folder "Personal Address Book". When

you create a contact, the newly created contact will be automatically added to the Personal Address Book. If you open the Contact List window, you will see the folder "Personal Address Book" at the top left. If you delete an account, the Personal Address Book will be synced with an account. If you delete the first personal address book in the account, the Personal Address Book will be deleted. For more information, see the Contacts Sidebar documentation and the Contacts Sidebar FAQ. In Thunderbird you can either click the mouse on the contact to select the address book, or use the search field to select the contact in the sidebar and use the search field. ❖❓ Contacts Sidebar is compatible with all address books Thunderbird supports.
